


Tuition Rates

Please keep in mind that tuition is determined on a case by case basis using an income sliding scale*. We have three program options to fit your child's learning and your needs.

Tuition Options	Average Rate*
Tues. & Thurs. (<i>three-year-olds</i>)	\$30 - 45
M, W, F (<i>four-year-olds</i>)	\$45 - 60
Full week (<i>all ages</i>)	\$100

Our Tuesday and Thursday program is for three-year-olds and our Monday, Wednesday, and Friday program is for four-year-olds. The all-week program is for all ages. The tuition increase for those who attend all week is a result of extra lesson plans needed and assignments to accommodate a child's level of learning. We have a \$25 enrollment fee for every new student. Tuition payments are due every week on Friday and charged one week in advance. Payments can be made online via our website under the Pay Tuition tab, in person, or over the phone at (940)383-3332.

Denton Christian Preschool offers developmentally age-appropriate learning activities that educate and challenge our children. Our theme-based curriculum offers a new and exciting way to teach our children the basics while keeping them engaged with new topics incorporated each week. A new curriculum has been implemented to include phonics, sight words, and interactive technological learning tools. DCP children practice core skills that prepare them to be at or above grade level when they begin kindergarten such as:

- Science concepts through the use of simple tools and by asking questions that help guide them through discovery and introduces them to critical thinking.
- Learn and practice good handwashing in the classroom during various times throughout the day.
- Experience writing opportunities every day and are provided with a wide variety of materials to choose from.

We provide transportation to and from school (within Loop 288 and I-35) and to field trips, three nutritious meals: breakfast, hot lunch & afternoon snack, story time at the Denton North Branch Public Library once a month, music/art time, nap time, recess, monthly parent meetings and we practice safety drills and protocols.
